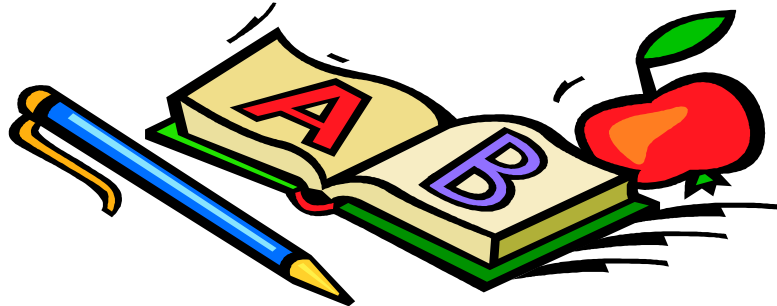


NJAIS Mentoring Roundtable Presentation & Discussion
